

# WOVEN TEXTURE FLOORING MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

- The choice of color and style affects maintenance requirements, same as the entrance and stair areas. Select furniture without sharp corner.

- When using wet cleaning method, it is recommended to use clean water. Only use cleaning agents in specific areas.

- Never use strong acid cleaning agents, detergents or strong solvents as these items may damage the flooring.

- When cleaning agents must be used, please use neutral cleaning agents with PH7~PH8.

## 1. After installation

Flooring installation should be carried out after all other install (such as ceiling and wall) completed. If not, protect the flooring with plastic film or carpet. Use a vacuum cleaner to remove any scattered garbage and dust, then use a comb dryer clean it.

## 2. Routine maintenance

- Daily: For all maintenance, use dry-cleaning-method as much as possible, to reduce cleaning cost and extend flooring lifetime. Most of the time, using a vacuum cleaner is enough (preferably a vacuum cleaner with a rotating roller brush). If necessary, use water and mop clean it. The mop should be frequently washed and wrung dry, and the water should be changed before it gets dirty. If using cleaning agents, the most important thing is to clean them afterwards clean with water twice.

- Periodically: Use a vacuum cleaner to clean the floor, then use a comb dryer with a vertical rotary brush to clean it. Must be a soft brush. If cleaning agents are used, clean the flooring twice with water. Machine can be used directly without cleaning agents.

| Stain  | Cleaning agent   |
| Blood  | Cold water and Ammonia   |
| Fruit, Cream, Juice, Milk, Red wine, Beer                        | Neutral cleaning agent, add Ammonia if necessary   |
| Excrement, Vomit, Urine  | Neutral cleaning agent   |
| Rust   | Neutral cleaning agent and 10% Oxalate   |
| Asphalt, Chocolate, Grease, Coffee, Oil stains, Shoe polish, Tea | Neutral cleaning agent, can use soft foam cotton cloth                                     |
| Ink, Carbon paper, Pen, Printer ribbon, Lipstick                 | Denatured alcohol  |
| Adhesive   | Adhesive cleaner and wipe with dry cotton cloth carefully                                  |
| Gum, Paint   | Cover with ice or cold water and scrape off with knife carefully                           |
| Cigarette burn marks   | Scrape off with knife, then drop some polishes and use stain remover to polish the surface |
| Shoeprints   | Wipe with a dry cloth  |
